FINAL PROGRAM LISTING

Each exhibiting company must submit a 50-word company description for the scientific program. Descriptions longer than 50-words will be edited without approval from the exhibiting company. The description should be sent before July 15, 2019. Company descriptions received after this date may not be included in the final scientific program.

EARLY ACCESS FOR EXHIBITORS

Booth personnel are permitted access to the Exhibit Hall one hour before and one hour after the official exhibit hours. An exhibit badge is required for entrance.

BADGE IDENTIFICATION

All congress participants and guests must wear a World Sleep 2019 congress badge at all times. Badges allow entrance to the scientific sessions and access to the convention center. Exhibitors will pre-register attendees. Badges will be available at the Registration Desk upon arrival at Vancouver Convention Centre.
