



Young Investigator Awards

Overview of Awards: Young Investigator Awards will be offered to qualifying individuals at World Sleep 2022 Rome. Oral abstract awards will provide the opportunity for up to 18 individuals to present their abstract during a special young investigator oral abstract session. Poster awards will be presented to up to 24 authors of the top ranked young investigator poster abstracts.

Requirement: 35 years old or younger **OR** less than 5 years post MD or PhD degree.

Oral abstract award: Complementary registration and a travel grant of up to \$1,000 USD (depending on distance of travel) to give a 10-minute oral presentation included in a special oral abstract session during the congress.

Poster abstract award: Monetary award of \$500 USD per winning poster

Deadline: November 30, 2021

Review Process

The young investigator awards will be selected from submitted abstracts. Abstracts submitted by award applicants will be evaluated in two phases:

Phase 1 (General abstract review): Award applicants will be notified of their acceptance for an oral or poster presentation. Acceptance of an oral or poster abstract **does not** imply the author will be selected to receive a young investigator award.

Phase 2 (Young Investigator Award abstract review): Following the November 30, 2021 deadline, the applications will be reviewed, and award recipients will be notified by December 31, 2021.
