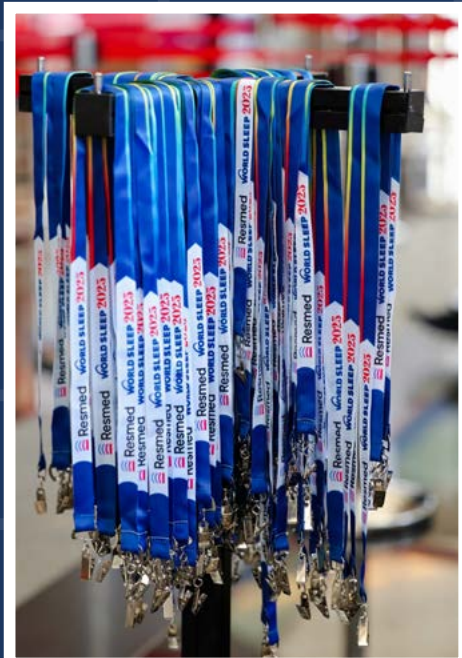

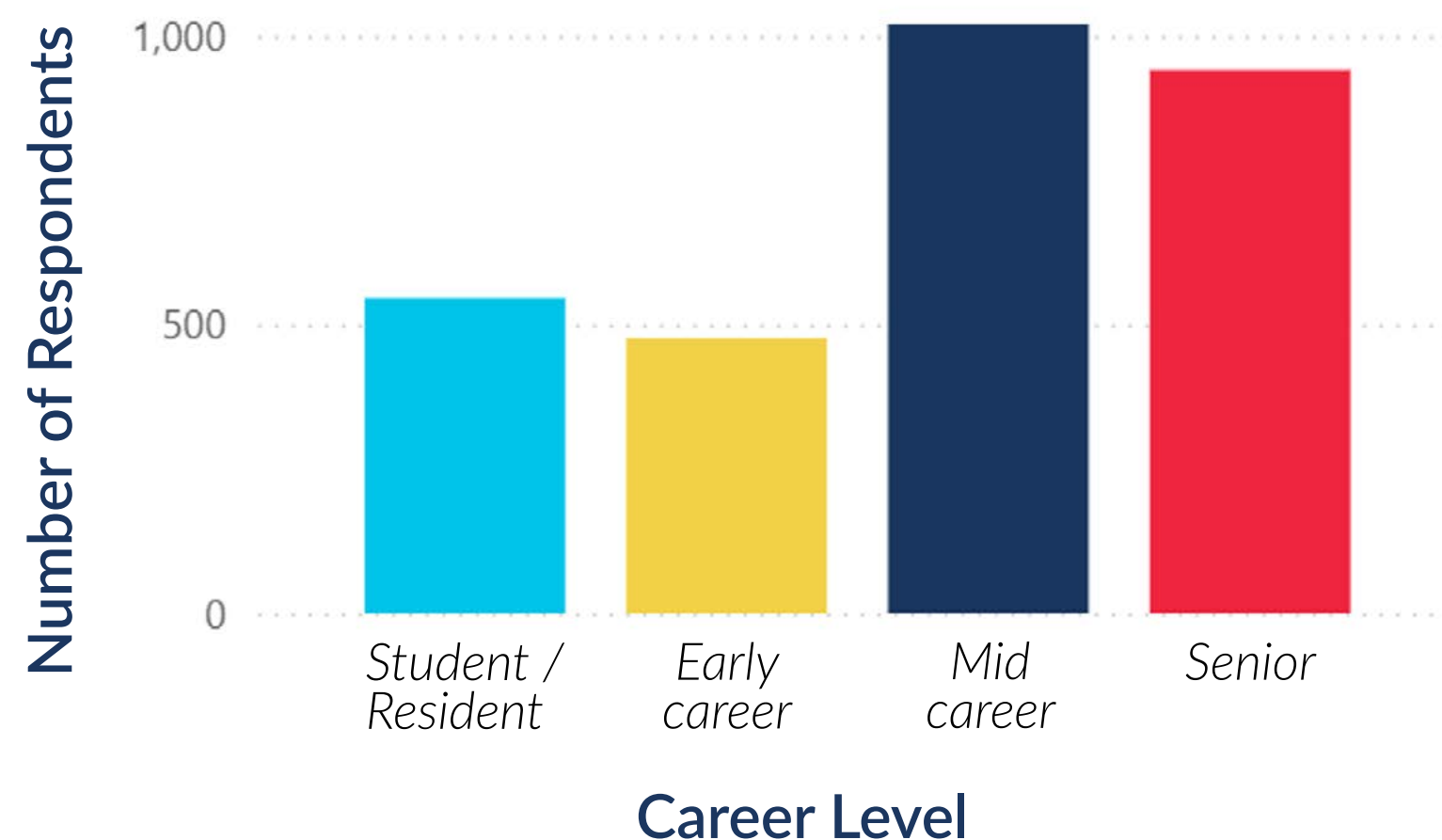

How would you describe your career level?

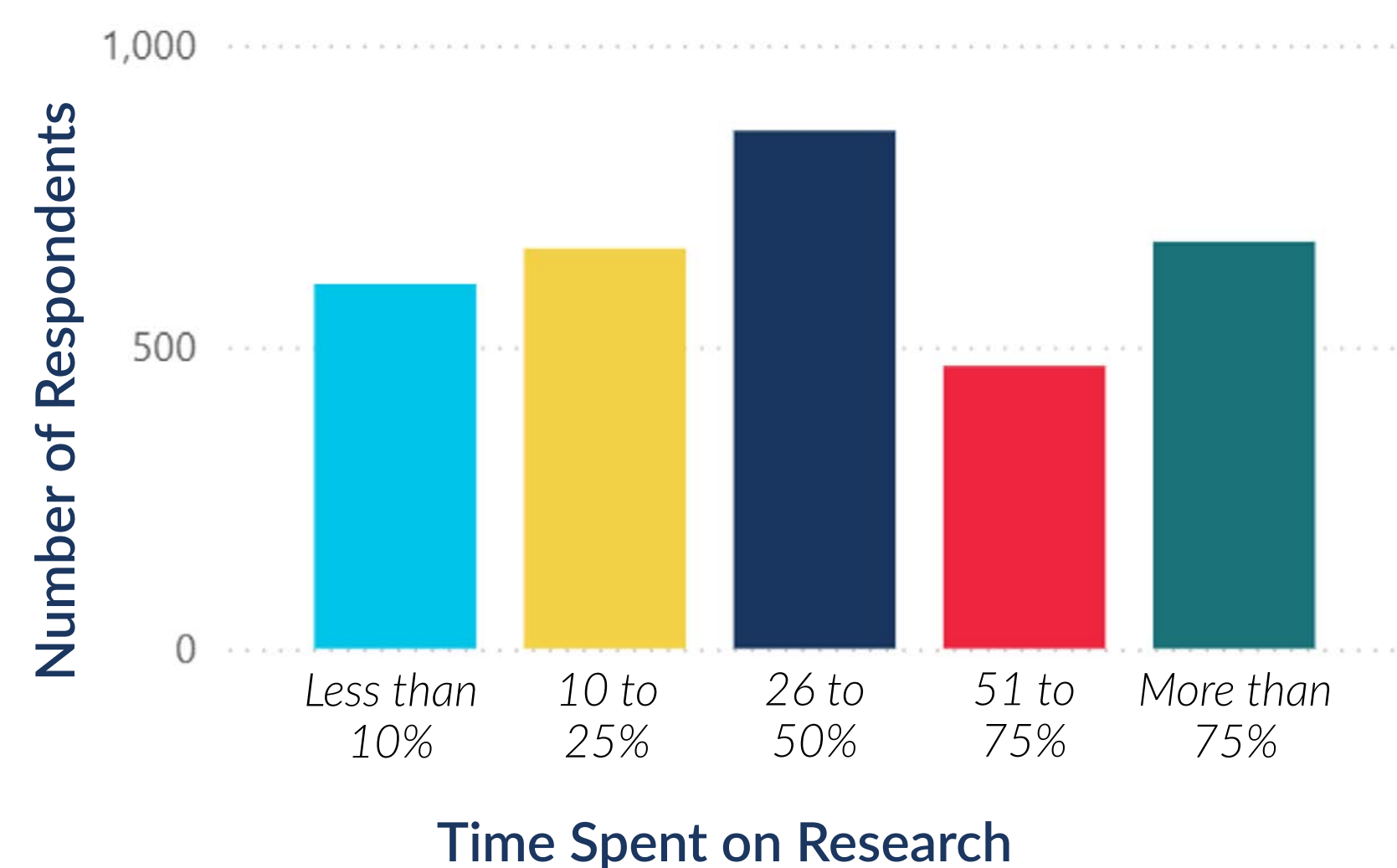

What percentage of your professional time is devoted to sleep medicine research?

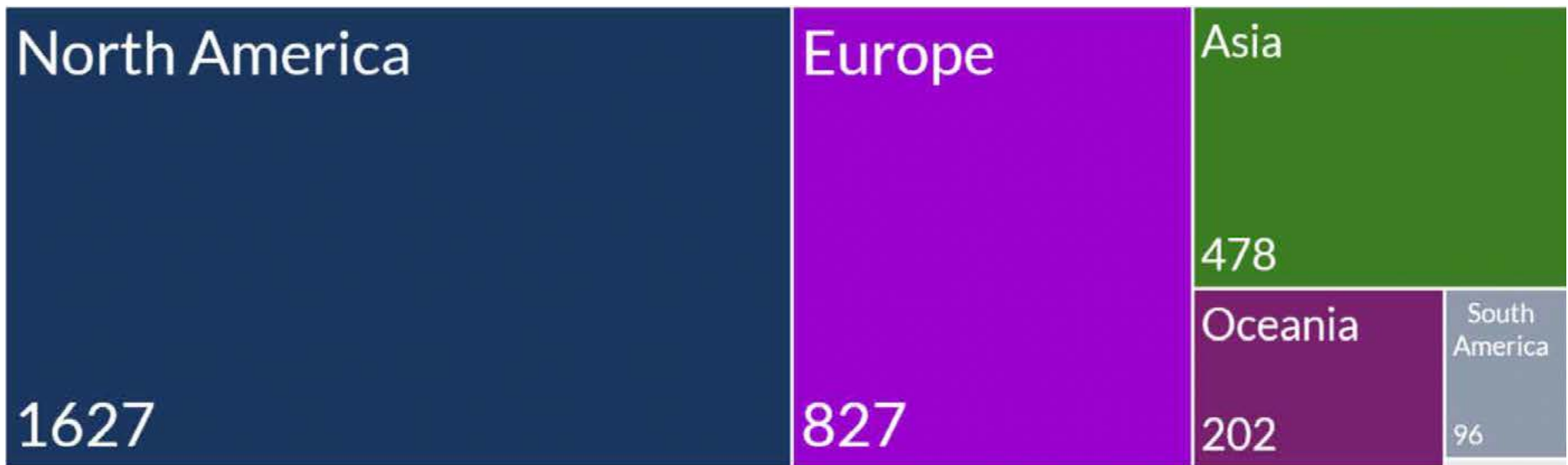


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World Sleep Historical Attendance by Region

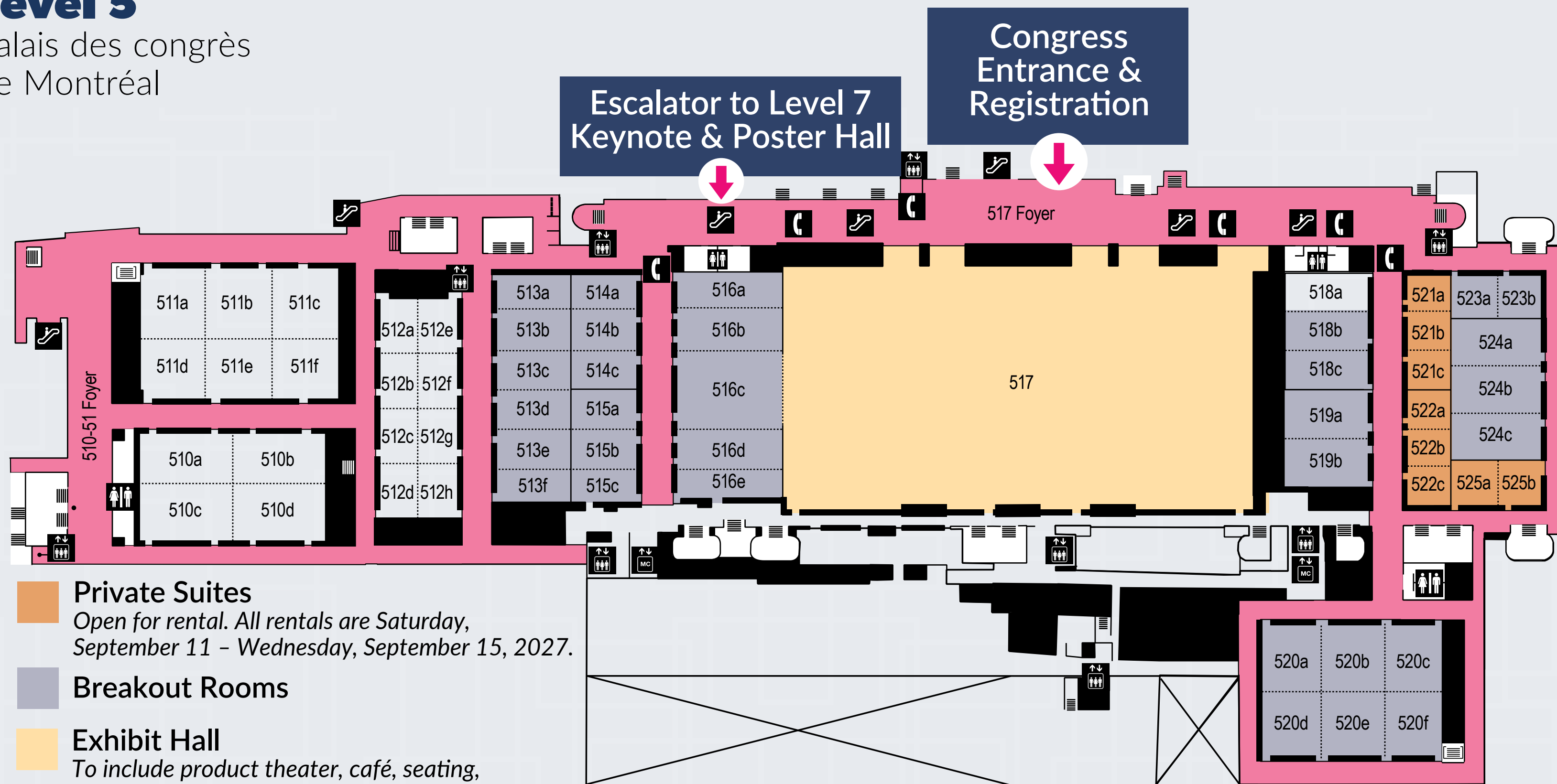

The exhibit hall is expected to include 80+ exhibitors, a cafe with seating, a product theater space, and constructed meeting rooms.

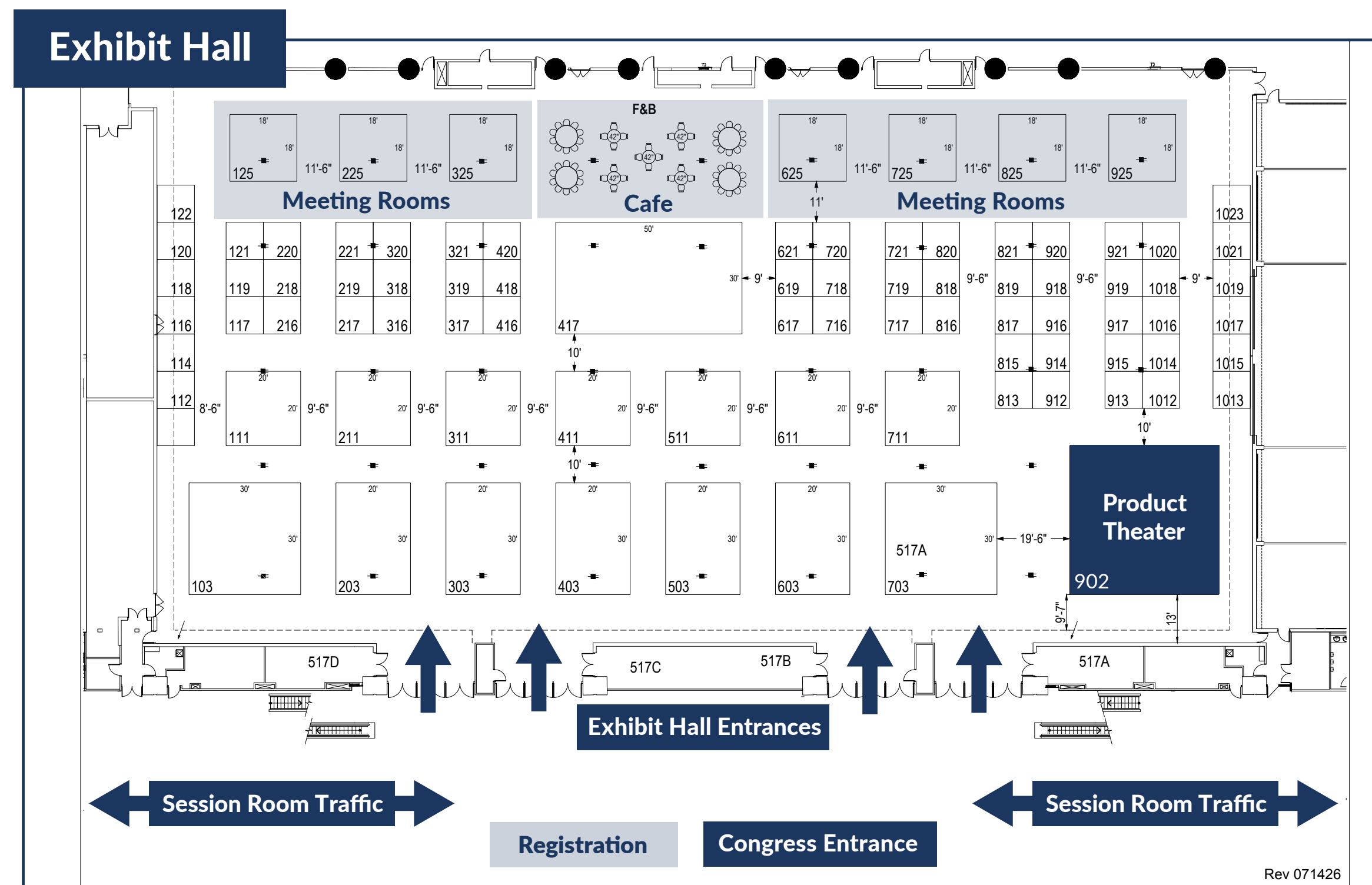
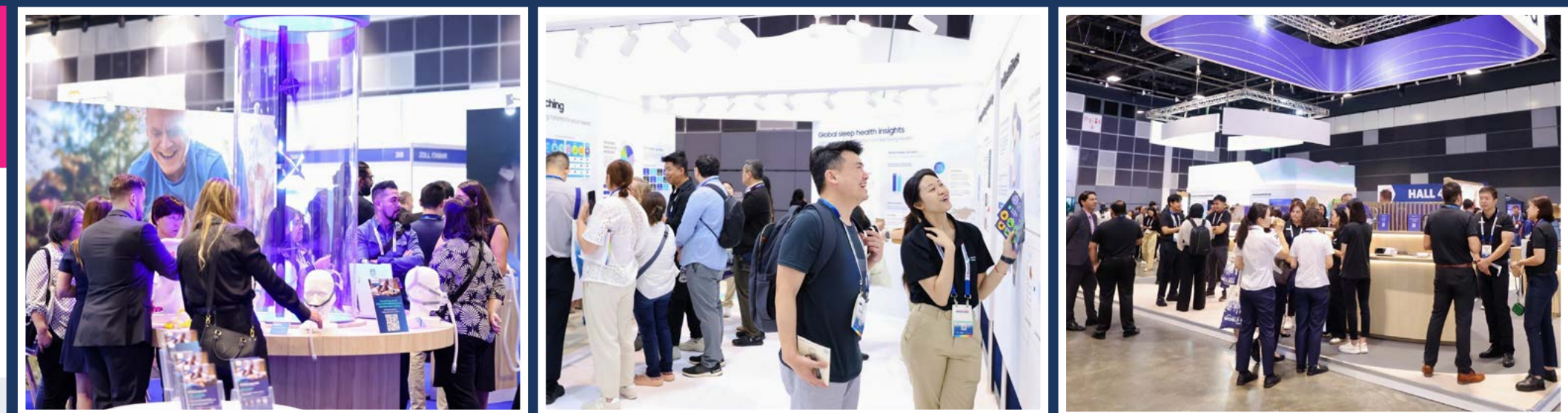
